Filing a wrongful death claim in Tennessee

If your spouse dies due to someone else's negligence, you are eligible to file a wrongful death claim. If the victim had no spouse, the claim may be filed by the following persons, in order:

- Surviving children
- Surviving parents
- The estate's personal representative

Wrongful death is a civil claim like any other [personal injury](#) claim. There is a one-year statute of limitations, meaning you must file your wrongful death lawsuit within one year of your loved one's death.

Wrongful deaths can arise from many different scenarios, including:

- Construction accidents
- Car accidents
- Slip and fall accidents
- Defective products
- Medical malpractice
- Physical violence
